

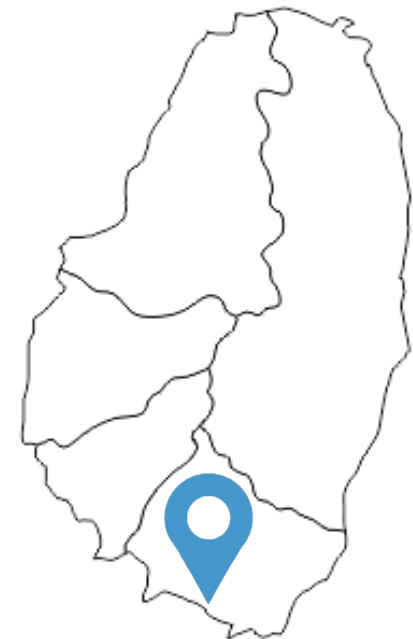


Kingstown Technical Institute (KTI)

Kingstown Technical Institute (KTI) evolved from an amalgamation of the Home Economics Centre, the Richmond Hill Technical Centre and the Business Centre. In addition to offering full-time one-year TVET courses leading to CVQ Level 1 and 2, KTI services a cluster of local secondary schools in the Kingstown area by offering Caribbean Secondary Education Certificates (CSEC) TVET and CVQ Level 1 programmes. As part of the SkYE programme KTI will train 180 disadvantaged young people including Persons with Disabilities over a three-year period. The institute's vision is to be a premier TVET provider by 2021, making maximum use of digital and technological facilities to support quality TVET provision.
