As part of the SkYE programme, SADO will train sixty disadvantaged youth and persons with disabilities in CVQ Level II Crop Production. This skills training seeks to increase the supply of labour of skilled and unskilled workers in Agriculture specifically crop productions in Grenada. A competency-based approach will be used for delivery of the program. 80% will involve practical and 20% theoretical based activities.
