

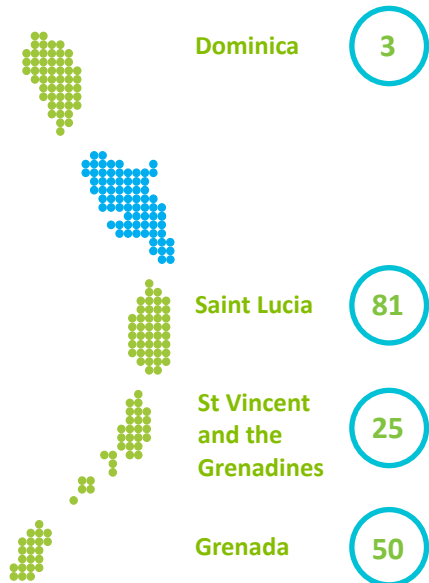

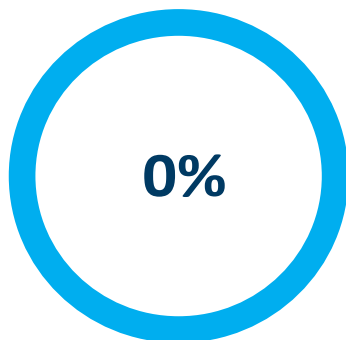


Employers Survey on TVET in the Caribbean and the Employment of Young People with Disabilities

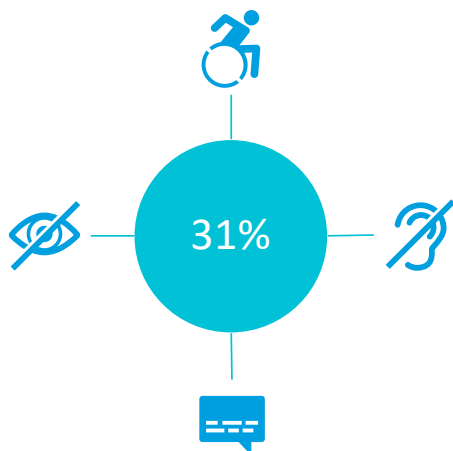

Employers expressing a preference for TVET certified employees



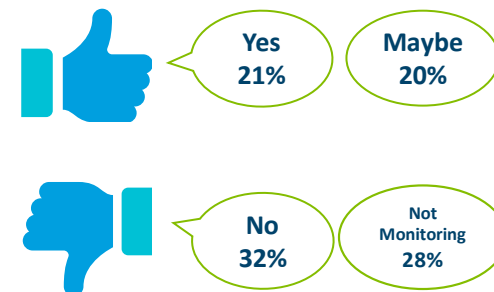
Less than a third of employers actively employ persons with disabilities (PWDs)
